**Busking Risk Management**

Orange City Council permits busking in Summer Street to provide a pleasant ambience to the street for shoppers, and allowing the buskers, mainly students, to raise funds.

In accordance with the Occupational Health and Safety Regulation 2001, Chapter 2, a Risk Assessment must take place prior to commencing this activity. The Risk Assessment is to identify hazards, assess the risks and develop controls to eliminate the hazard or minimise the risk to the lowest reasonable level.

Following a workshop to assess the risks associated with busking the following Hazards and Control were identified.

Hazard	Control
Tripping over busker	Buskers to occupy location allocated by Council. Footpath width available to pedestrians a minimum of 2.4m when busker is performing. Maximum of 4 people in busking group. Buskers not to intimidate or hinder pedestrians.
Tripping over buskers equipment	Buskers to keep equipment (including cords) away from pedestrians, (see above). No sandwich boards on footpath.
Noise	Council limits the number of buskers to 6 per day. Buskers to perform in allocated position.
Robbery	Buskers to keep funds on display to a minimum.
Motor Vehicular Traffic	Buskers to keep near shop wall and away from traffic.
Assault	Permission obtained from adjoining business owner. Performance during normal business hours. Permit to be available to Rangers while performing.

Contact Council if there is a dispute between buskers. Ring Council's after hours contact on 1300 650 511 if the Rangers are not available. Advise the Safety Officer if someone is injured due to busking.

Buskers will be responsible for their actions.
