The Young Citizen of the Year Award recognises an individual under 25 years of age who has achieved something extraordinary, is an inspirational role model to others or who has made a sustained outstanding contribution to the local community.



**COMMUNITY

of the year**

The Community Group of the Year Award recognises a group who has made a valuable contribution to the Orange community throughout the year.



**COMMUNITY
EVENT
of the year**

The Community Event of the Year Award recognises an event that has made a valuable contribution to the community. This will be determined both in relation to the quality of the event and the scope of impact on the local government area.

Local Legend Award recognises a person who has moulded the Orange local community with outstanding, illustrious or renowned achievement.



**BUSINESS

THE SUPPORTING STATEMENT MUST OUTLINE HOW THE NOMINEE HAS MET ONE OR MORE OF THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA:

- Excelled or achieved something extraordinary in their area of endeavour;
- Been an inspirational role model to the Orange community;
- Significantly contributed to the Orange community.

• Regard will be given to the length and type of service performed by the nominee (i.e. in a voluntary or paid capacity)

• **Nominations will be open to Australian citizens working or living in Orange**

- Young Citizen of the Year nominees must be younger than 25 years of age as of 26 January, 2021
- Previous winners cannot receive the same award more than once
- Only one nominee in each category will receive an award

• Nominations will be accepted until close of business, Wednesday 16 December 2020

• The decision of the Orange Australia Day Committee is final

• The Awards cannot be made to an actively serving Local Government Councillor, State or Federal politician or currently employed Local Government staff

• Awards will not be granted posthumously

• The nominator agrees that they are not aware of any information regarding the nominee that might bring disrepute to the Orange Australia Day Awards program

• Nominations will only be accepted on this original nomination form

• Nominations for outstanding sporting achievements are not considered as part of the Australia Day Awards and should be submitted for consideration in the Orange Sports Awards.
