FOOD AND GARDEN WASTE BIN

Ash (cold)	Garden clippings/leaves
Bones	Grass cuttings
Branches (broken up)	Hair & fur
Breads/cereals/ grains/nuts/seeds	Meat (raw/cooked/skins/bones)
Cereal slops	Napkins
Chicken bones/skin	Palm fronds & palm tree nuts
Cooking oil/fats (frozen, wrapped in paper)	Paper towel
Coffee grounds	Pizza boxes (soiled)
Dairy products	Plant cuttings
Eggshells	Prawn heads/shells
Fish & bones	Tea bags & tea leaves
Fish & chip paper	Tissues
Flowers	Vegetable scraps
Food leftovers/scraps	Weeds (all)
Fruit & vegetable scraps	Wood: untreated (less than 30cm long x 15cm wide)

The following items can be delivered to the **Community Recycling Centre** located at the **Ophir Road Resource Recovery Centre** for free and will be recycled.

Only household quantities (20kg or 20L) of each waste type are accepted.

Batteries (car and household)

E-waste (electronic items)

Fire extinguishers

Fluoro tubes and light globes

Gas bottles and cylinders

Oil (cooking, motor and heating)

Paint & paint tins (oil-based and water-based)

Smoke detectors

The following materials can be delivered to the **Ophir Road Resource Recovery Centre** for recycling:

Bricks, tiles and concrete (fees may apply)

drumMUSTER-eligible containers
