DEVELOPMENT APPLICATION (NOT BEING DESIGNATED DEVELOPMENT)

DA 43/2021(1) - SAMPSON STREET (BETWEEN BYNG STREET AND SUMMER STREET), ORANGE

Notice is hereby given that a development application has been made to Council seeking approval for:

Temporary Use of Land (FOOD week luncheon)(Sampson Street)

The proposal involves a lunch for 300 people as part of the 2021 FOOD Week events, to be held on Sampson Street, between Byng Street and Summer Street, Orange. It is intended that the lunch will take place from 12:00 noon until 5:00 pm on Saturday 10 April 2021. The road will need to be closed from 8:00 am to 6:00 pm. Cooked food, drinks, and alcohol will be served to seated ticketed guests. Temporary structures include tables, chairs, portable toilets, fete stalls, generator, PA system, waste storage, water stations, and first aid station. The street will be cleared immediately following the event and then reopened to vehicular traffic.

The proposal will be on land described as Sampson Street, between Byng and Summer Street, Orange. The applicant for the proposed development is Food Week Committee. The consent authority is Orange City Council.

The application will be on public exhibition from Monday, 22 February 2021 to Monday, 8 March 2021. During this period, any person may make written submission on this development proposal to Council.

If a submission includes objections to the proposal, the grounds of objection must be specified. Submitters are required to comply with section 10.4 (Disclosure of Political Donations and Gifts) of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*. Submissions close at, and must be received by Council by, 5.00 pm on Monday, 8 March 2021.

In inviting submissions, Council advises that:

- (1) Any information provided to or collected by Orange City Council is for the purpose of assessment of a development application.

- (3) The intended recipients of the information are Council staff, the developer, the public and Councillors.
- (4) The making of any submission is entirely voluntary.
- (5) The person providing the information has a right to access the information to correct any personal information supplied.
- (6) The submission will be placed in Council's file and may appear on Council's website during the consideration of the development application.
- (7) Council's file on the development application may be accessed by any person.
- (8) Signatures, personal contact details, personal financial information and photographs depicting persons will not be made available on Council's website.
