Notice is hereby given that a development application has been made to Council seeking approval for:

Helipad

The proposed development seeks Council's consent for a Helipad. An existing farm shed will be used to house the helicopter and a concrete landing surface is proposed to be located just to the west of the existing shed. The proposal involves the operation of a Robinson R44 Raven helicopter, and helicopter movements will be limited to 7 per week (including take-offs and landings). The helipad will only be used by the property owner and not for commercial purposes.

The proposal will be on land described as Lot 100 DP 1092868, being 360 Phoenix Mine Road, Huntley. The applicant for the proposed development is Mr M P Molloy. The consent authority is Orange City Council.

The application will be on public exhibition from Friday, 23 April 2021 to Friday, 7 May 2021. During this period, any person may make written submission on this development proposal to Council.

Submitters are required to comply with section 10.4 (Disclosure of Political Donations and Gifts) of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*. Submissions close at, and must be received by Council by, 5.00 pm on Friday, 7 May 2021.
